

Reiki Benefits

Reiki can support pregnancy in many ways, including:

- alleviating morning sickness
- reducing stress and fatigue
- supporting healthy fetal development
- easing discomfort in muscles, joints, and the spine
- nourishing the baby with loving, calm energy that comforts and protects
- helping maintain balance in mind, body, and spirit, which may reduce the risk of postnatal depression
- accelerating recovery for both mother and baby after birth, including support for cesarean healing and postpartum stitches
